INVITATION FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, Cook County, Illinois, that sealed bid proposals will be received for the following improvement:

“Intersection Improvements, IL RTE 171 (First Avenue) and Strieby Drive”

The work consists of PCC pavement modifications, PCC curb and gutter, temporary traffic signals, permanent traffic signals, traffic signal interconnect, temporary traffic control and protection, final restoration as well as other related work as shown on the plans and as described herein. The project is located at the intersection of IL Rte 171 (First Avenue) at Strieby Drive in the Villages of Melrose Park and River Grove, Cook County, IL. The length of the project is 1,198 feet (0.23 miles).

Sealed bids will be received up to the hour of 11:00 o'clock A.M. on Thursday, the 15th day of February 2018, in the office of the Village Clerk, Melrose Park Civic Center, 1000 N. 25th Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois 60160 and will be publicly opened and read at that place and time. Bids delivered in person will be accepted weekdays between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM.

Bidding documents, consisting of the bid proposal, plans, and project specifications, are available at the office of Gewalt Hamilton Associates, Inc., 625 Forest Edge Drive, Vernon Hills, IL 60061, upon payment of a non-refundable charge of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per set of bidding documents. The Engineer has been authorized to refuse to issue specifications and proposals to any person, firm, or corporation that he considers to be unqualified. No bidding documents will be issued after 4:00 P.M. on Tuesday February 13, 2018.

All bid proposals offered must be accompanied by a bid bond in an amount not less than Five Percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid or a cashier's check or certified check, made payable to the Order of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Melrose Park, as a guarantee that if the bid proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of the contract properly secured. No bid proposal shall be considered unless accompanied by such bid bond or check.

The Contractor and Subcontractors shall comply with all regulations issued pursuant to Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130) and other applicable Federal Laws and regulations pertaining to labor standards. The contractor will be paid in cash for the work to be performed on this project.

In accordance with Section 3.04.020(B) of the Melrose Park, Illinois Municipal Code, specific consideration will be given to any responsive and responsible Melrose Park Business in evaluating bids. The Village of Melrose Park reserves the rights in receiving these bids to waive technicalities, to reject any or all bids, and to determine solely at its own discretion which if any alternate scope of work is to be awarded.
